FFP1, FFP2 and FFP3 are different classes of respirator and they offer varying levels of protection to the wearer assuming they fit and are used correctly.

Such respirators are designed to filter out particulates such as dust, liquids and fume. A simple colour-coding system exists to help you easily distinguish each product's filtering performance. FFP stands for Filtering Face Piece.

The HIGHER the number, the BETTER the protection.



FFP1 reduces the wearer's exposure to airborne particles by a FACTOR OF 4



FFP2 reduces the wearer's exposure to airborne particles by a FACTOR OF 10



FFP3 reduces the wearer's exposure to airborne particles by a FACTOR OF 20
